WHO IS JESUS CHRIST?

Professor Simon Greenleaf was one of the most eminent lawyers of all time. His "Laws of Evidence" for many years were accepted by all States in the United States as the standard methodology for evaluating cases. He was teaching law at a university in the United States when one of his students asked Professor Greenleaf if he would apply his "Laws of Evidence" to evaluate an historical figure. When Greenleaf agreed to the project he asked the student who was to be the subject of the review. The student replied that the person to be examined would be Jesus Christ. Professor Greenleaf agreed to undertake the examination of Jesus Christ and as a result, when he had finished the review, Simon Greenleaf personally accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his Saviour.

Professor Greenleaf then sent an open letter to all jurists in the United States saying in part, "I personally have investigated one called Jesus Christ. I have found the evidence concerning him to be historically accurate. I have also discovered that Jesus Christ is more than a human being, he is either God or nothing and having examined the evidence it is impossible to conclude other than he is God. Having concluded that he is God I have accepted him as my personal Saviour. I urge all members of the legal profession to use the "Laws of Evidence" to investigate the person of the Lord Jesus Christ and if you find that he is wrong expose him as a faker but if not consider him as your Saviour and Lord"

HOW CAN I BE SAVED?

Salvation is available for all members of the human race.

Salvation is the most important undertaking in all of God's universe. The salvation of sinners is never on the basis of God's merely passing over or closing His eyes to sin. God saves sinners on a completely righteous basis consistent with the divine holiness of His character. This is called grace. It relies on God so man cannot work for salvation, neither can he deserve it. We need to realise that the creation of this vast unmeasured universe was far less an undertaking than the working out of God's plan to save sinners.

Thirdly, by the exercise of my own free will I personally receive the Lord Jesus Christ as my Saviour, believing that He died personally for me and that He is what He claims to be in an individual, personal and living way (John 1:12; 3:36; Acts 16:31: 4:12).

My sins are taken away (John 1:29),

I possess eternal life now (1 John 5:11,12),

I become a new creature in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17),

The Holy Spirit takes up His residence in my life (1 Corinthians 6:19),

And I will never perish (John 10:28-30).

This truthfully is life's greatest transaction. This is the goal of all people; this is the ultimate of our existence. We invite and exhort any reader who has not become a Christian by trusting in the Lord Jesus Christ to follow these simple instructions and be born again eternally into God's family (Matthew 11:28; John 1:12; Acts 4:12; 16:31).

PROVIDENCE AND EBCWA

"I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." John 15:5.

INTRODUCTION

It was the habit of Christians in the past to keep a list of the Providences of the Lord, which not only gave great comfort and confidence in life, but also gave testimony to those grieving at their burial as to how the Lord had provided for that person in their life.

The following record is a short account of just some of the providences of the Lord for the Evangelical Bible College of Western Australia to point to the absolute fact that as a Christian individual or Christian organisation, "Without Christ we can do nothing", and also, "with Him we can do things that are thought impossible". As we look back from February of 2020, preparing the update of USB 2020, we stand amazed at what the Lord has achieved and the joy we have had in the process of walking with Him into totally impossible places and seeing God do amazing things in the most difficult personal circumstances.

Obviously we cannot include all the items but we trust that this document will encourage Christians as we testify to the faithfulness and provision of God, and to the importance of trusting the Lord, His power, and His Word. We have learned through the years not to trust the management manuals and systems of men.

The College began in the heart of God who laid a burden on two men in different countries who didn't even know of each other when they both were led to develop training resources with an eye to dealing with what they both saw as serious pastoral training needs for local churches in their respective countries.

John McEwan in Auckland, New Zealand, and Peter Moses in Perth, Western Australia, both started to prepare training material for use by those who shared the burden to not just reach the lost, but train them into full Christian maturity. Both felt the power of Jesus commands in **John 21:15-19**, for all pastors to protect the flock, feed the sheep, and feed the lambs! They were burdened with the need for systematic teaching to provide new believers with a structure to their faith, and for older believers for real understanding of doctrine based hope as they readied themselves to meet their Lord face to face.

JOHN McEWAN AND THE DIPLOMA COURSE

In the late seventies John McEwan was burdened about the need for systematic Bible teaching in the churches that were only doing week after week, "three point sermons", which were often completely unrelated to each other! He saw that there was no systematic growth or spiritual strength amongst the young men and women who were being saved, for they were not hearing exegetical, categorical teaching, with the historical context of the scripture being understood. Those being saved were remaining "baby" like in their faith and service; they were emotionally nourished by warm fellowship, but he saw they were drifting away after a few years in the churches, as they had not built a growing relationship with the biblically revealed Lord Jesus. He could see the Scriptures needed to be taught as they were revealed – verse by verse.

The denominations were introducing more entertainment focused activities, topical church teaching, and more family focused programs to hold superficial people, but there was still no powerful spiritual growth, because there was no systematic understanding of the deep things of the Scriptures. People were limited in what they could do for God, because they simply didn't know the real Almighty God of the Bible, for they didn't know their Bible systematically! Both he and Dr Moses saw that the Bible needs to be taught as the Holy Spirit revealed it to the human authors; verse by verse and line upon line! Isaiah 28:9-15. They were both appalled by the lazy ministers who didn't feed the Lord's flock. Ezekiel 34:1-11.

John finished his University study and worked as a teacher and social worker, but was led to begin to study for his doctorate in theology in 1979 completing the degree in 1986. Through this study time he worked as a shift worker while he studied, (7am to 3pm, or 3pm to 11pm, occasionally 11pm to 7am) as a member of the Talley Clerk's Union and later the Waterside Workers Union through this time on the tough Auckland waterfront. During this time he also ministered in a variety of churches; Open Brethren, Baptist, Congregational, and Presbyterian, filling in preaching where churches had no regular ministers.

He also served as a voluntary lecturer within the Capernwray Ministry in the late seventies and early eighties. He was also a sailor and later officer in the Royal New Zealand Naval Volunteer Reserve through these years (1978 onwards) finally retiring in 1996 as a Lieutenant Commander.

It was this full time work and full time study together, without compromise to marriage and family life, that taught him the ruthless time management and Holy Spirit empowerment that he came to believe was at the heart of powerful biblical ministry. It is ruthless time management that sets apart those who are used by the Lord, and those who are pew warmers, but achieve little beyond pleasant fellowship, or political intrigue for sectional interests on the church board. Both he and Dr Moses saw that most believers talking of God doing great things with them, were actually doing little, and that saturation in the Word daily and allowing the Holy Spirit free reign within the life was the only starting point for genuine service.

Visits to John Wesley's house in London reinforced this concept to him, as he prayed before Wesley's open bible in his little prayer room off his bedroom. Wesley was up by 4am and studied and prayed-prepared for his ministry day until 7am, and then he assisted the staff with breakfast preparation. Those who are lazy or casual with their usage of time will not achieve much in ministry. If television, smart-phone, social media, or "internet surfing" rules a man or woman's life they will not be as well used by the Lord as He intends us all to be! The Lord "hammered" this into him through these years as he worked, studied, preached and served in church and Naval ship or establishment. "Servant Leadership" has been the concept that was central from the start.

1986 was a "powerful" year for John. In 1986 John completed his doctorate and was awarded a Doctor of Philosophy in Bible (Pastoral Theology). Prepared by study, he needed to be refined by suffering.

A MAJOR CHANGE IN CIRCUMSTANCES

Within one month of graduation John was gassed in a Naval training exercise that went badly wrong, when an officer who should have known better let off two smoke bombs in a confined area not designed for their use. Sadly he was the only other believer amongst the officers! (John was safer with the pagans!)

The exercise was being held in the SAS and Naval underground training complex located in old WW II tunnels to the north of Auckland. Lieutenant McEwan, as he was then, was in charge, and so had to be the last man out of the complex, to ensure he had all his sailors out, and that all were safe.

He staggered on with work on the waterfront, ill and unable to breath properly each day for the rest of 1986 through to September 1987 when his health completely collapsed, and he was given no hope of recovery by his doctors. It was the same time as the collapse of the world economy, so his pension fund lost a quarter of its value when it was paid out as he was unable to work! It was three years later, as a result of prayer alone, that he returned to paid work! Romans 8:26-28 needed to be rested in through this testing time.

"My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." 2 Corinthians 12:9

It was during this terrible time of illness, with his immune system collapsed and with John barely able to breathe for many days at a time, that the Bible College Diploma lectures were written, as the Lord burned into him the passion for training young men and women to serve the Lord, and used the very writing and giving of the lectures as his main "therapy" for slow recovery.

It was on the Auckland Waterfront one day earlier in 1986 also, that he met a Harbour Board shed keeper, another Peter, who provided an introduction for him to a pastor who sought to establish a Bible College for young Maori and Polynesian assistant pastors in his fellowship. This Peter also casually handed John the first two Bible Topic Books (the blue and red books) saying, "you may find these interesting".

Everything came together within a few months. In the next four years of physical debility and human hopelessness the lectures were written, and then given, as energy was provided by God alone each day. The ruthless self-discipline learned through the doctorate and waterfront work came together to produce, in the power of the Holy Spirit alone, the focused energy to write the course content and modify the earlier Capernwray lectures that formed the basis for some of the lectures. It was the Holy Spirit's power being so evident in a terribly sick man that impressed the first students with the course – for they could see that only God had enabled him to write it, let alone teach it. All saw the power of the Holy Spirit, for John looked and felt better at the end of each teaching session, when at the start of each session some thought he might die before finishing the night's lectures.

PROVISION OF A BIBLE COLLEGE IN AUCKLAND

John met with this pastor in December of 1986. There was no money, no building, no infrastructure to support a College but they prayed together with the motto, "let God do it, or let it not be done!" John made the observation to the pastor at that time, "I prefer impossible situations for then only God can do it and only God gets the glory then". This comment proved prophetic for the development of this first prototype College and the present EBCWA work world wide, but also for his life from that point onwards.

If any person had looked on they would have mocked, for John was a very sick man, barely able to breathe, not expected to live, and the pastor had no building and no money at all for the project, yet they prayed together for the resources to establish a College. What they did have was nearly forty Maori and Polynesian men and women needing training, and a united belief that it needed to be done, and the time was right for the Lord to act in Auckland in this way. Even though this man would later prove persistently carnal, there was a genuine spiritual need to train the amazing group of young men and women at that church, and God met that need.

By April of the next year, 1987, a City Council owned leasehold property with a church building and large hall on it was "gifted" to the College/fellowship by a defunct church board that couldn't use their building any more and according to their trust deed had to pass their assets over to a "like minded" group. All this was occurring while John's health remained medically hopeless, and the world economy collapsed later in September of 1987, and the following years were ones with little available money for most people. From the toughest soils the greatest fruit emerges when God's hand is in it. The Holy Spirit was moving, and that was all that mattered. He learned, get your eyes off the bank balance and onto the Lord's will.

The building was given with a bank balance of \$11,000-00, which proved sufficient to repaint the building, repair and replace the kitchen, and put in the toilets that were needed. Many volunteered their time for the Lord; both plumber and electrician doing so, as well as many willing painters. In June of 1987 the College began with the introductory series of lectures given and recorded. The rest of the year was spent preparing the young students for the study that would begin in earnest the following year. Many of the students were unemployed due to the financial collapse of 87, and many had poor formal education. The Diploma Course would be the start of success in formal education for many of them, and the start of real ministry.

Because John was not expected to live through the years 1988-90 the introductory and diploma lectures given in those years were recorded on four track tapes and then placed onto cassette tapes for distribution. Thirty-seven men and women graduated with their diplomas over the years 1990-1991.

THE PROVISION OF THE RECORDING EQUIPMENT

Just before John had needed it, a four track tape recorder was given to him by a fellow Christian brother, Al, who was heading to Australia to live. He also gave John large quantities of reel to reel tapes. Within the year these were used in the Bible College to record the 540 hours of Diploma of Theology Course lectures. At the time there was no clear reason to have the large professional quality tape recorder and over 150 four track tapes, but they were accepted with thanks, and prayer was offered up as to their future use.

God's timing and provisions in each of these things was critical, as without the Naval accident it is probable that the series would not have been recorded, and without the gift of the tape recorder they couldn't have been recorded in good enough quality for duplication. Two of the students were experts in recording technology and without their attendance, nothing would have been recorded properly. Each of these things was woven together by God, and without any item EBCWA would not have been later formed, nor the Diploma books provided for a teaching and training resource throughout the world. Four track tape would be transferred to cassettes, then cd, then into mp3 and onto the USB and websites – technology moving ahead, but with God's provision to exploit it and always to stay ahead of the technology and be led to use it fully.

God has repeatedly provided things in advance of any seen/understood "need" and we have become used to asking quickly what God wants us to do when otherwise "weird" things occur. We have also learned that God's timing in His provision is critical to notice and pray about. We have learned not to trust our minds ability to work things out, but to prayerfully move forward into each and every opportunity that opens up, without expecting at the time for it to "make sense" from a human perspective.

Jeremiah 10:23 "Oh Lord, I know that the way of a man is not in himself. It is not in man that walks to direct his steps."

THE SEEDS OF EBCWA

Around 1991 it became clear that the pastor of the church, within which the College had been set up, was in persistent sin in some areas of his life and John, having failed to get the man, or others, to face the problems, had to separate from him. This was done quietly and without fuss, and all the tapes had to be got back from the Church Bible College, which the pastor wound up within months of John's departure.

It is interesting to note that prior to the pastor's fall into obvious sin that he had been mightily used of God, and been the chosen vessel to set up the College. He had also been instrumental in John's healing through prayer in accordance with **James 5:14-15**. He persistently however rejected the calls to deal with the problems that were present in the church and his behaviours remained problematic.

It is sad to reflect that this man had been used to share in the establishment the College, been used to heal John through prayer, and yet refused to accept John's gentle correction of sin in his life, and so was side lined in the Lord's work. God was gracious with him however, and for seven years he had time to repent. Seven years after John's departure his church fellowship was wound up (from 300+ people to zero!), and the pastor was disgraced by open exposure before his Board of the very hidden sins he had refused to face 7 years before. John was called and used to do this sad work of judgment.

The College had done its work in Auckland by that point! All the recorded reel to reel tapes were to be sent to Perth to establish the new College, but for a year they were in storage in John's garage. The man who had done all the duplicating of tapes into cassette format died within a month of handing over the four track tapes, and had there been any delay in obtaining them they would have all been wiped and reused for the fallen pastor's Sunday messages! The very building in which all the teaching was done, and EBCWA established, was swept away by urban development by the end of 2015.

Proverbs 3:5-7A. "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths. Be not wise in thine own eyes...."

As part of this initial college in Auckland all the students were bought a set of the first two Bible Topic Books as part of the course for their private study. John began to correspond with Peter Moses in Perth and sent over new doctrines to Peter, and there was a mutually beneficial relationship established, and then the opportunity came for Peter to visit Auckland for a Traffic Engineering Lecture tour and they met face to face for the first time on November 5th 1991. John had by then moved on into another church, which was the old one he had been saved in many years before, Blockhouse Bay Baptist, and he supported the ministry there for the next seven years.

On 5th November 1991 Peter and John and Elizabeth (John's wife) had a pleasant dinner and discussion together and shared the visions of the Lord for their lives. John shared the work at the Bible College and the material he had from it. Peter made the casual comment that he would like to hear a tape or two. By sea mail within a few months 540 hours of tapes arrived in Perth and the Evangelical Bible College of Western Australia was on the road.

From 1991 through until early in 1998 John was involved in many preaching and teaching opportunities in many different churches, but they were all short term, and the main focus was in preparing the training material to build upon the Diploma Course, and in the re-writing of the Diploma Course. In 1991 Peter and he had agreed that they needed to prepare a full biblical commentary written to empower pastors in the Third World and provide systematic teaching, with word studies and the Bible Topics woven into the text.

This was John's main focus through these years, with all lecture series given in the churches he had opportunity to minister within, and Sunday service church messages preached through these years being testing opportunities for most of the new material written.

Everything written for the College was to be "battle tested" in local church contexts and then fine tuned for more and more power. This process of constant rewriting and refining would continue right through until this year of 2020. There was no other encouragement to do this task than that given by the Holy Spirit within each other; indeed other pastors said to them, "there are enough commentaries; you're wasting your time".

Had they heeded the "nay sayers" they would not have done the work that has been a blessing in the Third World to so many thousands of churches. They both learned to heed the Holy Spirit's prompting, and not "check things out" with those who thought they knew God's Power, but were not actually listening to God at

all. Sadly the most negative brethren were those who thought themselves most spiritual by their charismatic emotionality. The danger of emotion, without doctrinal foundation, or really sitting with the Lord, and listening and hearing the Holy Spirit speak was clear! God's message to them both was, "Wait upon the Lord" – sit with the Scriptures daily and hear the Spirit's move in your heart through the feeding on the Word of Life.

John was led to a new house/work place, and then to a new fellowship in 1998, and served there as a voluntary Bible Teacher, running a Mid-week Bible study and a breakfast Bible Class every Saturday morning, beginning with about 20 people, building to over 80 attending by 2016.

The opportunities in this place started to close by the end of 2016, and the Lord opened another door through what initially appeared to be a disaster. It was at these classes over 18 years that he was able to test teach the various commentaries being written, and especially refine the Leadership material. Many training books were written through these eighteen years, but the greatest expansion of the training material was in the toughest years of John's life, from April 2004 - 2020.

From April 2004 right through until now in 2020 our Dean has faced overwhelming financial pressures in a situation of complete entrapment, unable to sell his home, and always within a month or so of financial default. It has been a time when the Lord has proved again and again his grace provision in utterly impossible situations from a purely human perspective, from day to day and week to week. Financially the pressures through this time have been humanly impossible, yet they have been the crucible for the production of the writing that has achieved God's purposes in ways that have amazed all.

The decision to buy this property has been seriously examined, in light of the financial disaster it has proven to be, and yet it is clear, he was led to this place, and all the spiritual connections and learning, opportunities for service, and blessing that has flowed from 1998-2020 has been due to being positioned in this place of extreme and humanly hopeless pressure. Had he not been in this place he would not have met the people that have been central in much that has unfolded through this time.

Jeremiah 51:33-36. Speaking of the evils done by Nebuchadnezzar, as by the malice of the trustees of the land that the Dean faces. "The time of harvest (judgment) will come (upon the oppressor)..... He has devoured me, he has crushed me, he has made me an empty vessel...Thus saith the Lord, I will plead your case and take vengeance for you.....". God moved and Nebuchadnezzar himself was saved (Daniel 4).

Isaiah 49:23. "I am the Lord. Those that wait for Me shall never be ashamed...." **Isaiah 26:3**. "He will keep him in perfect peace whose trust is in Him."

Haggai 2:4. "Take courage and work, for I am with you, Says the Lord."

The Dean remains in this home and has minor debt after over twenty one years of unimaginable pressures, and it is still humanly speaking impossible, and has worsened in recent years, with a giant water pipeline being dug through his street, forcing him to move his work place in 2016 at even greater increased cost (more below). The principle remains however, that God's best work with us all has been done in the most tough places. God has been and continues to always be, Great, Good, and Gracious.

The key point the Lord has made to us all through the years of EBCWA has been, "Be faithful and work! Leave your problems firmly in God's hands, He will deliver! Cast your cares upon Him alone. Wait upon the Lord". As a dear friend says of the Lord; "We are to do His Will and He picks up the bills!" His Plan, His Power and His Time. It is God's Plan, so it cannot fail, for He cannot fail us, for we are His, and all that happens is about His Glory.

Psalm 27:4, 13-14. "4. One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple....13. I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living. 14. Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD."

Isaiah 64:6. "6. But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away".

The verses that were pillars of doctrinal strength through the first terrible years of overload pressure were Psalms 31:22-24, and 1 Chronicles 4:9-10. The challenge of the Lord was to turn the spirit of heaviness into the garments of praise in worship, **Isaiah 61:3**, and this was achieved. Many Commentaries were

completed in both 2004 and 2005 on the New and then Old Testament. (Refer Addendum for specific details.)

- **Psalm 31:22-24.** "For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before thine eyes: nevertheless thou heardest the voice of my supplications when I cried unto thee.
- 23. O love the LORD, all ye his saints: for the LORD preserveth the faithful, and plentifully rewardeth the proud doer.
- 24. Be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart, all ye that hope in the LORD."
- **1 Chronicles 4:9-10.** "And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, because I bare him with sorrow. 10. And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested."

In **2006** the Lord opened the door for the Dean to visit Tanzania to speak to the African Leadership Training College at the Joshua Foundation in Arusha, and a visit was arranged to coincide with this trip to speak to the EBCWA leadership in Dar-Es Salaam. The topics taught were Revival and Renewal in the Local Church, and Christian Leadership. These seminars resulted in the two books (112, 113) on these subjects on our CD/flash-drive. Six further commentaries were produced for the initial CD on the New Testament. The Lord encouraged the Dean with the texts for the year, Jeremiah 10:23-24, and 17:7-8.

Jeremiah 10:23-24. "O LORD, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps.

24. O LORD, correct me, but with judgment; not in thine anger, lest thou bring me to nothing."

Jeremiah 17:7-8. "Blessed is the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

8. For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit."

In **2007** both the parents of the Dean's wife died this year within five months and the family faced major challenges with the steadily deteriorating health of the Dean's own elderly parents. The Lord strengthened through this all and encouragement was drawn from 1 Chronicles 22:11-13. In this pressure filled year nine teaching commentaries were completed on the books of Genesis through Leviticus.

- **1 Chronicles 22:11-13.** "Now, my son, the LORD be with thee; and prosper thou, and build the house of the LORD thy God, as he hath said of thee.
- 12. Only the LORD give thee wisdom and understanding, and give thee charge concerning Israel, that thou mayest keep the law of the LORD thy God.
- 13. Then shalt thou prosper, if thou takest heed to fulfil the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: <u>be strong</u>, and of good courage; <u>dread not</u>, <u>nor be dismayed</u>."

In **2008** the Lord kept encouraging through His Holy Word this year, with the command/promise of Philippians 4:11 being central – "Be content in all things". Hebrews 11:1-3 reminded us all that our focus needed to be forwards towards the tasks to be completed, not around to the problems surrounding us. This forward focus has remained our theme and message through these terribly stressful, but powerful years. God's message has been consistent through these years; do not look back except to give thanks, do not look around at the pressures or the attitudes of others, but look forward to the assigned task and move forward in the Holy Spirit's power to do what you have been asked to do! We are to do His will, and God's job is to pick up the bills, smooth the right road, and protect us! Ten Commentaries were completed this year on the books of Numbers through Judges.

Hebrews 11:1. "Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

- 2. For by it the elders obtained a good report.
- 3. Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the Word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear."

In **2009** both the Deans' parents sickened and died within eight days of each other, and there was great business pressure with the world financial crisis (WFC) deepening, but it was the most fruitful year for writing ever, with eighteen (18) commentaries written on various books of the Old Testament. This involved nearly 1 million words typed in a year, with normal work and other demands, an utterly impossible result under such overload human pressure. Truly the Holy Spirit empowers in difficult places. The words of Isaiah 26:3-4 and

49:23 encouraged him and his family through very dark, pressure filled, and humanly impossible days. Keep noticing the principle that emerges consistently from this ministry; pressure situations with faith applied open the door to be part of amazing God anointed opportunities for blessing forever. Eternity not space-time!

Isaiah 26:3-4. "Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.

4. Trust ye in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

49:23. And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me."

In **2010** the prisons of Southern Africa opened their doors to the ministry of the EBCWA Diploma Course and a meeting was held in Perth to coordinate this with the South African Prison Fellowship and Bible Society directors. A further fifteen commentaries were completed this year by the Dean. The last of these books thus completed all the commentaries on nearly every book of the bible. We had set ourselves the task of achieving this goal twenty years before and it was finished by December of this year. Haggai 2:4 encouraged through this year and we ended the year in joy in the midst of great pressures still. The writing work to provide for the pastors of the poor churches however was not done, as the Lord would later show us!

Haggai 2:4. "Yet now be strong, O Zerubbabel, saith the LORD; and be strong, O Joshua, son of Josedech, the high priest; and be strong, all ye people of the land, saith the LORD, and work: for I am with you, saith the LORD of hosts:"

In **2011** one of the students attending the Bible School in Auckland quietly presented a cheque to the Dean after a Saturday breakfast bible study. It was a cheque for thirty thousand dollars, and was given for "printing books". This money was used throughout 2011 and 2012 to ensure that all the active learning centres in the Third World have a full set of printed books to train their students. By the end of 2015 the last of the printed books had been sent out, with just the original master copies to be printed on the back and made into two libraries (completed by 23 September 2015 – thence to two colleges in Africa – the first arrived in Ghana early December, the second to Zambia in December also).

This has involved several tons of material going out to places from Perth world wide, all to be used for training believers for ministry. All this from a gracious gift from a beloved sister who hears the Holy Spirit's guidance in her soul and does what the Lord directs. The gift has been able to be 100% put into material, as we have no administrative costs that we do not all meet ourselves. It is of note that the two worst time periods of world financial crisis in recent times (1987-1991, and 2008-2012) have been the times of greatest blessing and productive work for the College, especially for the writing.

It reminds us all to look upwards to the Lord for confidence and strength and look around for topics for prayer only. No appeals are made for money, except to the Lord, and the Lord has had a habit through the years of meeting needs well before we even see them! We have learned to listen, and respond quickly to tasks assigned to us. We do not seek anything other than the Holy Spirit's direction, and it has never been lacking.

In 2011, the 20th year of EBCWA, the Prisons and Churches of Nigeria began to open to the work and the final steps were taken to finalize the format and content of the CD that was to have the nearly completed library on it for late 2013, although with revisions it would only be finalized by December of 2015 (Minus Chronicles – more below). God's Words to us were "Shabbat-Amen" – have faith in God and rest in his provision, person, power and plan! Philippians 4:6-7, Hebrews 4:8-9. Major revisions were undertaken of all the commentaries through this year, with the addition of a number of new topical books, the first on the Arabs in the end times, and also book 270 on the lessons of the Great Revival of the 18th Century.

Philippians 4:6. "Be careful for (worried about) nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God.

7. And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

Hebrews 4:8. For if Jesus had given them rest, then would he not afterward have spoken of another day. 9. There remaineth therefore a rest to the people of God."

This year 2011 the Mainland Chinese "Three Selfs Church Seminary" asked the Dean's Church fellowship for a course in Ethics and in Biblical Counselling, and our Dean developed these, with power points, and in

addition a full power point program was developed to teach the whole Bible chapter by chapter, and they are now included as notes and power points on the new EBCWA CD - File K – "Christian Counselling".

After nine financially difficult/impossible years, in 2012-2020 the Dean personally faced increasingly impossible financial pressures, and yet the Lord has delivered in a staggering manner, by weekly ensuring that just enough work came into his business to pay all bills. Like George Muller he saw the grace of God to meet requirements daily and weekly, and requirements have always just been met, but often with exceedingly great pressures accompanying them, and many questions asked about the pressures by close family. "The Just Shall Live by Faith". Habakkuk 2:4. The Lord held work back at key times when there was money shortage, but writing to complete for the latest CD/USB, to ensure the work was done, and then the "tap" of divine provision for his paid work poured once more. "Jehovah Jireh!" Genesis 22:1-14.

These times were and remain significant faith tests as still money drains away with no human hope to replenish the bank, and on this pressure time the Lord made it clear to him that he was to have faith and keep writing/revising the books on the USB/CD until the task was done. God isn't being "mean" any more than a good athletics coach is "mean" when they ask the athlete to trust them and work harder, and so grow stronger. This occurred as the last commentaries were revised and the Arabs Book, and the Leadership and Revival Manual's were updated and revised for African and Middle Eastern Outreach work. At the time there was no clear opening into the Middle East, but the Lord had a new door opening that none guessedthrough the Tamil churches world wide (below).

In the worst possible time financially for him, the Lord opened the door for the Dean to train pastors in Nigeria, and also train others in the Middle East through our Director there, but also through the Tamil led churches, both areas through the use of the Leadership Manual and the other Pastoral Books that he was led to write through these most difficult times, as the WFC continued to devastate economies world wide.

The Holy Spirit led the Dean to rewrite the Leadership Manual for Christian work within Moslem contexts, (without any obvious reason before him – just the urging of the Holy Spirit within) and to test the book by teaching it in Auckland in October-December 2012. Two of his students, husband and wife, were Nigerian, and felt the Lord burden them to take the Manual to train some Nigerian pastors they were in contact with in Lagos/Ibadan, and "Light of Life Children's Bible Ministry" leaders, over that Christmas time.

In God's perfect provision, donations came in in late November 2012, and 2500 manuals were locally printed in Lagos, Nigeria by 20 December, and over 2500 pastors and church leaders were trained over Christmas 2012 - New Year 2013. Local translations were then made and a complete revision of the Diploma Books (Books 1-13) was completed by the Dean by May 2013, so that these African Churches could use the material in a more powerful way. These continue to be used in many Nigerian seminaries/churches in 2020.

Five Major missions have now been sent into Nigeria and Ghana, with this beloved brother and his wife leading and teaching them, covering most major denominations and their seminaries. The costs have been significant, with the 2017-2018 trip costing \$65,000-00 NZD (travel, books printed and expenses – no pay for anyone involved). Such trips would not have even been attempted if we had been working by business models, for there was minimal money at the start, but the shared conviction by all who prayed about this that the Lord's hand was in this trip as with the others. No planning meetings were held, but prayer was continually offered, no appeals made; the Lord ensured that money came in and the mission was a success.

Simultaneously to this massive expansion of the work in West Africa, the Tamil speaking churches of Southern India (and the Middle East) opened their doors to the material by the hundreds. The Book on the Arab Nations in the end times had been revised, and so was ready to be sent into the Middle East Churches, many led by Tamil preachers. A terminally ill Tamil speaking brother in India did the translating of a number of the books as his final work before entering heaven. These Tamil translations are on the USB as the "John Vincent Raj Memorial Library". The appointment of a Middle Eastern Director and West African Director has further extended this work that quietly impacts the entire Middle East.

The Lord's miraculous provision was seen again in 2015 when the second visit to Nigeria was being prayed over, with the very dangerous Northern Provinces opening up and asking for a conference for a further 2500+ pastors. A prayer request went out, specifically asking that no money be sent, but just the issues prayed through by all supporters of the ministry. All were sure in the Spirit that the mission was to go ahead, but delayed until December 2015, and three individuals believed that they should give, and \$7500-00 was donated for the additional costs, and this amount met nearly all the needs for the mission printing and other administrative costs in Joss and to the far north where the "Boko Haram" operate.

Over 500 churches have been burned and thousands of believers murdered by these evil men, but the Lord has opened a door to us to train the surviving ministers, that they might, by truly biblical leadership, meet the Lord's standards and lead the Lord's people into the Word. In this seminar (December 2015) over \$3000-00 was charged by the local police to offer "protection" to the churches, and graciously a believer provided that amount and the churches were indeed well protected and no attacks occurred. 11 Boko Haram terrorists were however arrested on their way to attack the churches a week before the Conference was scheduled.

The Lord's Word had come powerfully to the Dean in April of 2012, with his personal money draining away weekly, to stand firmly upon the Rock that is Christ Jesus, and express the faith of George Muller, in "Jehovah Jireh", knowing that Our Lord will provide. Muller's work has become our example, and that wonderful brother is our Mentor from heaven. **Hebrews 11:1-3, 12:1-3**. The following verses were impressed upon his heart in dramatic ways. Read these brethren and be encouraged to stand by faith in the Lord as we have learned to do.

Zechariah 4

- "6. Then he answered and spake unto me, saying, This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, **Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the LORD of hosts**.
- 7. Who art thou, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel thou shall become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shouting, crying, Grace, grace unto it.
- 8. Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- 9. The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.
- 10. **For who hath despised the day of small things?** For they shall rejoice, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth."

Mark 11

- "22. And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.
- 23. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall **say unto this mountain, Be thou removed**, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.
- 24. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.
- 25. And when ye stand praying, **forgive**, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.
- 26. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses."

The Zechariah verse came to the Dean on 4 April 2012 as a firm promise to claim. On the 27th of April 2012 the people who control the sale of his house/land sent a malice filled letter to him that humanly speaking denied his chance to sell his property at all, robbing him of all equity, with their apparent plan to force him to surrender his property to them in the end, and so producing a new "mountain" of impossible stress and pressure, and this is still the situation in early 2020. On 21 April 2013 a visiting preacher at his local church brought together the two passages above in his message as a significant encouragement to keep plodding forward in faith. Like Joshua, the Dean was challenged to keep advancing towards the swollen Jordan River, expecting the Lord to open the path at the right moment! **Joshua 3:7-8.**

The Dean's challenge from that April day was to proclaim to the mountain he faced – "Be removed in Jesus name" – forgiving the Trustees of the land his house is built upon for their great evil towards him and all the over 100 other families caught by them. Seventeen families have lost everything they had in equity, marriages are broken, and health broken for many, and one man has taken his own life, and just under 90 families remained by 2020. He was challenged to firmly proclaim the victory of the Lord Jesus Christ over the trustee's apparent "mountain of malice" towards him and the others, and proclaim the victory to the glory of Jesus name.

The Lord's victory alone will enable the sale or purchase of this property that he might now move forward into any new ministry opportunities. Having completed this phase of his life and ministry – with the latest revision of the CD/USB drive (EBCWA-2020) to be completed by end February 2020 - we still expect the Lord to move in power and deliver. God's Plan alone, not our own. Isaiah 55:6-11 applies! Until that day arrives he expresses our common faith in saving aloud Psalm 37.

Psalm 37

- "1. Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.
- 2. For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.
- 3. Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.
- 4. Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.
- 5. Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass.
- 6. And he shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.
- 7. **Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently** for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass.
- 8. Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil.
- 9. For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth."

From this passage there is a great summary below of what others have called the "faith-rest principle", and we rest in these sure promises. ("Faith-Rest" = Faith in God and His Holy Word, and Resting in the promises of God's Word and the eternal security that is ours within His Plan.)

- 1. Fret Not He loves you all. John 13:1.
- 2. Faint Not He holds you in his hand. Psalm 139:10.
- 3. Fear Not He keeps you. Psalm 121:5.

The last commentaries were thoroughly expanded and revised, and several new ones added into the CD in 2013-2015, all Commentaries (except Chronicles, and post–graduate studies – more below) were completely revised by 9 November 2015 (the first Volume of Genesis and Revelation being the last ones revised and expanded), but a further revision was done under the Holy Spirit's prompting in late 2017, continuing into early 2020, with prophetic material added that Dr Moses had been led to write, and additional post-graduate training material.

A Minister's Manual was also produced and thoroughly revised to assist pastors in Africa without access to such a resource to assist in developing and running the various church services in a busy church, and a companion book on evangelism in the context of other religions completed. Systematic Theology texts were also thoroughly revised for Third World contexts where no text books existed.

These books are designed to be a resource for the Third World where such books are expensive and often too specific to denominations. This means there are now six additional very powerful and practical pastoral texts on the "Pastoral" file of the USB and CD set; Book 111 – Wellness from the Biblical Perspective, Book 112 – Leadership, Book 113 – Revival and Renewal, Book 114 – Minister's Manual, Book 115 – Other Religions that you Meet in Evangelism, and Book 270 – The Fruit of the 18th Century Great Awakening.

Local Russian Christian leaders in Auckland completed an introduction to the Leadership Course in early December 2014, and their burden is to take the EBCWA material to the 10,000 Russian speakers in the city of Auckland, then back to Russia through Vladivostok, and also into the Ukraine through Kiev.

Missionary work is being transformed before our eyes with Mainland Chinese people coming to New Zealand churches to learn English language, and staying to do bible study, never having met the bible before. ESOL ministries are opening up every day and many from Communist China, who have come to New Zealand for study are finding Jesus as Saviour and taking EBCWA material back into China to build the churches there.

The on line auto-translating applications are making it easier by the day to take any EBCWA document and translate them into all the major languages of the world, and the flash drive and cloud/"drop box" technologies are making borders irrelevant. Mordecai's words from **Esther 4:14**, come to mind, "Who knows whether you are come into the kingdom for such a time as this?" We have felt that we were being placed under pressure by the Lord to urgently complete the writing and re-writing work, and this has proved correct.

We have been challenged by the Lord to be ready for the applications that are just coming on stream now for "smart phones". Through the years 2015-2020 we have focused on re-writing material for this technology, as this will open the entire world to the use of the material. We are seeing the evil use of the Internet now by the enemy of truth, but at this point we can use it freely, and we will do so to get the material out freely and widely, as the Lord directs. We are now positioned by our obedience to be used of the Lord, and we rejoice in His mighty power, plan, and person. We are privileged to enjoy this service to the glory of his name. This last six years has been used to revise all the books for use on the new web sites that will be phone friendly – with material able to be loaded onto phones world wide for study.

18 October 2014 marked the Dean's 50th anniversary as a believer – meeting the Lord at Blockhouse Bay Baptist Church here in Auckland, and so it was good to mark that very day by teaching the Word to the local EBCWA Saturday Breakfast Bible study group.

Psalm 62:5. "My soul wait only upon the Lord, my expectation is only of/from Him".

Dr De Hann, a wonderful bible teacher of a past generation summed up the path that EBCWA would walk when he said in the 1950s, "When God is going to do something wonderful the path begins with difficulty, but when God is going to do something spectacular, the path begins with impossibilities". Praise God for His faithfulness and power through these last amazing years - and we look forward to what he is going to do in the next months and years as we hear his direction and move into new areas of ministry until called home. We still face impossible stress situations, and there is no human hope at all, but we wait upon the Lord.

Praise His Holy Name. **Isaiah 61:3** was a favourite verse through these pressure and at times tear filled years. Worship and service has transformed the great pressures of these now sixteen years of unimaginable financial pressures. The Dean's accountant, a wonderful believer who attends the bible studies, came in with good humour in June of 2015 and said, "I have got bad news and good news". The "bad news" was that the Dean hadn't earned very much money the last year, but the good news was that he didn't have to pay any tax as a result until May of 2016. This was good news as both the bank accounts were over-drawn.

Habakkuk 3:17-19a. "Although the fig tree shall not blossom, and there be no fruit on the vine, the labour of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat, the flock shall be cut off from the fold, and there shall be no herd in the stalls, yet I will rejoice in the Lord. I will joy in the God of my salvation, (for) God the Lord is my strength, and He will make my feet like hind's feet. He will make my feet to walk upon my high places."

We have learned to rejoice in the Lord and trust Him alone, and see his battlefield provisions arriving daily but with nothing over and an empty account each month, exactly as Muller and Wesley found monthly.

We seek his direction forward, and relax in his arms alone. **Deuteronomy 33:27**. There is hope in no other – it is the everlasting arms that we want to be carried by. God's Plan only; not ours! **Isaiah 55:6-11**, **Jeremiah 10:23-24**. As a beloved brother said recently, "It is the Father's Plan so it cannot fail".

Every year there is a challenge and a joyful event that reminds us of God's gracious provision and the need to trust the Lord alone. On Sunday 19th July 2015, a strong supporter of the mission tapped the Dean on the shoulder while he was at prayer at the front of the church, before the church service has begun, and gave him an envelope, in which was a cheque for \$12,000-00 for local ministry work. It would cover the cost of over 1500 USB devices for ministry material to be disseminated.

Humorously he was personally over-drawn by that amount exactly at the bank on that day, and so he chuckled at the Lord's humour, knowing that the Lord would provide the work for him also from the next day, and the blessing for his work, all in good measure, and at the right time. The Lord has taught him to ignore the personal bank balance, and focus on the work, and God sorts out the bank balance in His time.

Over the toughest times in 2016, when things looked worse than ever, an ex-prisoner had started mentorship with the Dean, and was taking leadership training (using the EBCWA Leadership Manual) with other exprisoners, and over twenty prison chaplains had just started meeting for prayer at the Dean's local church. The money in the local EBCWA account was seen as ready for local printing of material for the saved prisoners, (and the provision of a further 1300 flash-drives - below), and we gave thanks for a new door opened with the newly saved prisoners in recent years. The number of South African prisoners who have become pastors through the EBCWA Diploma program in prison there, has grown steadily, and some had starting contacting us by 2018 from their newly planted church ministries outside jail.

Provision of flash drives and double CD sets of written and MP3 material to take into the Third World is also covered by many significant unsolicited donations. There was in December 2015 an open door to provide up to 1100 flash drives to graduates of West African Bible Colleges and potentially be able to "load up" every newer church computer there.....as well as having 200 go into Zambia to church leaders through to Somalia and Sri Lanka. This was achieved by February 2017. The Lord is opening doors we wouldn't even have dared, or even thought to pray for, they were so far beyond our expectations or imaginings. The days are short; the Lord's work needs doing, and the Lord is opening many doors and providing the resources to achieve all he requires of us, without any delay.

John 9:4. "I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work."

Once again in the last week of July 2015, as Genesis Volume 1 was being revised, the Dean was without work, but enough work came in over the next weeks to pay the bills to the end of July. This occurred again through early August and with no work to pay the bills, the Dean celebrated his birthday by preparing two new 20 page Pastoral File booklets, the first Book 107, on the subject of "Suffering and the so called Prosperity Gospel", and the second on "Miracles and Our Readiness to Serve". Right at this time, his Van, used in ministry since its purchase in the early 1990s, had total engine failure on a busy motorway while doing 100kmph. Miraculous provision was experienced, as he was surrounded by large trucks and was able to disengage the instantly frozen engine drive and "coast" to a safe stop 200 meters away, but then he also faced greater pressure, as there was no money to buy any replacement vehicle. As he called AA for help it started to rain. Smiling with an upward look has become a spiritual habit – we look for God's solutions only.

After the completion of the writing tasks the tap of divine provision for work turned on again, and a beloved brother and his family purchased a replacement vehicle for John. This lack of financial provision in the midst of other great pressures occurred again in late November when Book 111 was written. This would occur dramatically again in March-May of 2019, with not enough work to pay the large bills at hand, but the Commentaries on Chronicles to be completed. We have learned – when pressure to worry grows, worship and do the work, and relax in the Lord's provision for money before the bills must be paid. The work of the Lord has been done without asking for help of any except the Lord! The Lord delivered!

This occurred again in January 2020, with dry rot discovered in the capping timber of a deck on the second floor. This could have meant the rot was all through the walls to the first floor level. Prayer was offered, worry parked, **1 Peter 5:7** was claimed, and a Christian brother, who has been our builder for years was called. Several weeks later the repairs were done, the walls were fine under the rotten capping, the capping was replaced, and praise given as the timber was painted for future protection. Just to make it interesting, dry rot was found in the skirting of his garage, and in support posts of his front fence, two large glass panels needed replacement at the front door, an entire row of tiles fell off the bath surround onto the floor, and the main entry gate opening mechanism broke. All this in a three week period! All were prayed over as costs could have been thousands of dollars, but all were passed to the Lord. Prayer alone keeps us stable.

The Lord's message came very strongly on 5 November 2015 (interestingly the anniversary of meeting Dr Moses and the establishment of EBCWA) at the Thursday teaching session in Auckland from **Daniel 10:10-15**, that the answers to prayers that he has sought regarding his house being freed for sale have already been answered, and that the challenge from this day onwards is to claim that reality, rather than pray about the present stressors that remain serious and threatening. **Hebrews 11:1**. This was confirmed by a prophetic word given by a pastor at the church on the 8th directly to the Dean, without the pastor being aware of the events of Thursday night. In the presence of the greatest pressures since being in his house he has been challenged to call the situation "solved" in the Lord and press forward in ministry opportunities which are opening daily, even though the financial situation still remains humanly speaking hopeless.

We have seen through the years that the worse the financial-work situation has been for Dr McEwan or Dr Moses that they have learned to simply do more written work and relax into the certainty of God's later provisions of work-money. As an example of this, through 2016-2017, due to the massive disruption of the giant pipeline in his street, the Dean had to move his practise to another site, and in God's perfect provision, Orakei Baptist Church opened its doors to him to use for counselling work on the last day required to move, and they invited him to speak several times. The retiring minister moved out of the church office on Friday and John began his counselling "tent making" work on the following Monday!

He was then asked to "contract" as "Teaching Pastor" to the church for Bible teaching for 2017-2020. This has led to the church growing, with Bible studies running Tuesday night, an ESOL study and outreach training program on Thursday morning, and a Thursday night study hour, and a breakfast Bible study before each Sunday church service. Up to 30 people attended each of the Bible studies by late 2019 and 60 are on the mailing list for the studies locally, plus more connecting on-line to hear the mp-3 recordings.

More are attending the new Bible Studies than had previously attended Sunday church! God's message – lift the Living and Written Word up, and the Holy Spirit will draw spiritually hungry people in. The local church is to be a light-house of truth, a place for Worship, training for spiritual Work, and evangelical outreach. **Matthew 5:14, John 21:15-19** is to be actioned and blessing will flow – and we see it does. **1 Peter 1:22-25**

We write **Romans 8:26-28** over the massive disruption of the giant pipeline, for what could have been a curse has become a blessing through the open door at the Orakei Baptist Church. Also through this time another unsolicited donation of \$20,000-00 was received, and this covered initial costs for the next mission trip to Nigeria and Ghana (December 2017) to train the Baptist and Anglican Ministers of the southern provinces, and teach at the Baptist and Anglican Seminaries. Over 10,000 leaders were trained in Biblical Leadership (Book 112), and a further 1000 flash-drives distributed through November-December 2017.

This was the fourth such mission, with over 20,000 leaders of all churches trained before this 2017 mission which saw another 10,000 trained. The costs of this 2017 mission were significant - \$5000-00 for flash-drives, \$9000-00 for air fares and insurances, \$22,000-00 for local costs as the team travels through Nigeria and Ghana, \$30,000-00 for books to be printed in Lagos (cost if printed in NZ would have been \$60,000 plus freight). Total cost for this mission was in the end \$66,000-00, and every dollar has been given without being asked for by believers acting on the conviction of the Holy Spirit alone. We had no planning meetings, no fund raising, and no appeals, just many prayer meetings. This is how God has guided us, so we can be encouraged as to the eternal results! New opportunities emerged out of this mission, and we were relaxing and praying about another mission for November-December 2018, and that came together the same way, by prayer.

God opened the door again after the success of the ministry with the Anglican Churches, and the Methodist Seminaries and Churches opened their doors with their Arch-Deacons/Bishops requesting training. The mission from 26 November to 20 December 2018 covered 3000 trainee Pastors, in both Nigeria and Ghana, and in addition a French translation of the Leadership Manual was made, and 500 copies sent into Benin, with a team from Ghana teaching pastors in French there. Large numbers of local pastors and people attended the Benin seminars, including Moslems, and a number were saved, and all encouraged.

This translation of the Leadership Book into French has now been sent out around the French speaking contacts we have world wide. 1500 flash-drives went in also on this trip for the ministry trainees and church leaders. Total cost was \$42,000-00, with once again no request made for funds, and with open doors, and much prayer. Great perils existed on the roads, and the team was again miraculously delivered from mortal danger this time, as in some earlier missions. 2 Corinthians 11:26-31.

As a result of this visit the Anglican and Methodist Arch-Deacons, and Bishops of Lagos and Ibadan asked in March for a visit by the Dean in October 2019. The subject for the talks he was to give, "The Last Words of the Apostles". Communication problems always plague organizing such things, but we relaxed into this, knowing God's hand is directing things. What was God's plan here? Major problems occurred with Visa application, and there was over-promising of the organizers of the Benin-Togo mission, and major questions hung over the venture, but we offered prayer and waited for clarity.

Prayer for guidance, and for the funding that would be needed to cover expenses in the Dean's business while away was the focus, and earnest prayer was offered the morning after the meeting at the Bible Class that announced the invitation had arrived.

Within ten minutes of saying "Amen" to that prayer a beloved brother turned up at the Dean's door with a gift of several thousand dollars and the message from the Lord, "just give this to John". It answered the specific prayer; provision will be there if he was away, and it met the immediate needs, with little work at that time to pay bills. God's specific promise came the next day, from Isaiah 60:20, "...the days of your mourning will cease".

The Dean needed to be ready to go, and even if he wasn't to be there at this time, being ready to go was the key point he saw needed to be confronted through the months of March – June! The Lord moved strongly upon him, to persist with the visa application, and to get the many vaccinations needed, at considerable cost, and prepare the material needed. By mid-June the last demands for the visa were made, and it was then shockingly clear that they could not be met; it appears the Nigerian Government does not want "visitors" at this time with the Northern Emergency – as it is impossible to safely meet their requirements. Prayer is required again. It was clear that the Dean needed to be mentally ready for this trip to be his last, and fully ready to face his death there this time, and he got to that place, but then the trip was cancelled. Where to now? Prayer again – as without his travel costs there was immediately more money for books and bibles.

After sixteen+ years of massively impossible financial stress he still remains unable to sell or move house, but weekly must meet costs that are humanly speaking always too great, and he has been nearly permanently in and out of overdraft through this last two decades. He begins every week without enough bookings in his tent-making work book to pay the bills for that following week! Yet, the Lord has kept him

going, and month by month the account is sufficient. God's timing for deliverance is what we are focusing our prayers on, for the recent events, and our brother's very specific guidance and provision tell us that if the Dean is to be ready to go to speak in any place the Lord calls him to.

Remember Brethren, God works best in the humanly impossible places, for then we cannot trust ourselves, and so we must walk in the Holy Spirit's power alone. **1 John 4:4.** This has been the story of our entire EBCWA journey, with no move forward being humanly speaking "possible" at any point on our journey. From the very beginning we have faced humanly speaking impossible hurdles and threats, and the Lord is to be praised, for He has done and is doing amazing and wonderful things to the glory of the name of Jesus our Lord, King, and Saviour. As we look back it is very clear, only God could have done this work.

On Wednesday night 15 February 2019 as the Dean and Dr Moses were speaking on skype an email arrived from Ghana-Benin via our West African Director. It reported that as a result of the mission journey in December revival has broken out in Benin and the door was wide open, and churches were working together that previously were being separatist. Both men felt the Lord's clear order, "Get moving and get the training material printed and get it into the French speaking churches of Benin, and Togo and Niger". The next night at the Bible study two cheques were presented, for a total of \$5000-00, which were sufficient to print 1000 of the French translations of the Leadership and Sunday School Teacher's manuals in Lagos, and cover costs for the Ghana French speaking team to go in and support and encourage the churches. We praised God, and were determined to get the written material into the French speaking countries! It was done by June.

As Dr Moses worked on the Prophetic Update through 2018, and then returned to the Perfect tense Studies, Dr McEwan was led to start work on Chronicles in 2019, to see if there was a need to write a separate Commentary, as much of its material is covered by Samuel and Kings. As he began to study the books he realised why the Lord had delayed this study until after the Perfect tense studies had been well advanced. He saw within a few weeks that Ezra's writing of Chronicles was the same as John's writing of the reflective Gospel of John after the time gap back to when the Synoptic Gospels had been completed.

He saw immediately that Ezra was challenging beliefs and behaviours in ways that were powerfully similar to the Apostle John, as he faced the gnostic heretics of the late 1st century. Ezra was calling the twelve tribes firmly back to their doctrinally secure foundation in the Law of Moses and the message of the prophets. Dr McEwan saw that this Commentary on Chronicles needed to be the last biblical commentary written, as the Perfect tense studies were essential to be understood first, as only then would Ezra's perspective in Chronicles make sense.

God's timing was then seen in the delay, as the books of Samuel and Kings were done ten years earlier, but Chronicles was delayed by the Lord, as He knew it had to be done in 2019!!! We had thought it didn't need to be done at all! We have both learned on our EBCWA journey with the Lord – be ready to be corrected. We have also learned to trust the Lord for provision, and work to the point of exhaustion, and advance through the "walls" of difficulty that appear before us. This God given message was tested again as Chronicles was being written with paid work drying up for the Dean – not enough to cover living costs week after week. The answer – pray about that issue, like all others, 1 Peter 5:5-10, and throw oneself into the work to get it done, knowing by faith that God will open up the tap of provision afterwards. Do not ask men!

We knew the Perfect Tense project for the 2020 USB was a vital one. The pressures on the Dean through the last months of work on the Executive Summaries part of the project have been immense. The work has been accompanied by testing at a high level. There has not been the paid work to pay bills, but there has been time to do the writing work! He had a root canal become abscessed, and it required a serious antibiotic to settle the infection and ease the associated pain. This medication unfortunately dropped his natural immunity and he succumbed to a viral flu that laid him low for six weeks, with fevers coming and going.

Just as the flu started to abate, work dried up again, and the top left incisor tooth snapped in half and required more money to fix, that wasn't there at the time. His left hip was painful through this time with nerve pain, and his lower back "went out". Through this sort of very physical and real financial pressure he has learned to pray, cast himself upon the Lord, and set his heart, mind and body to finish the writing work; this time for the Perfect Tense project. This sort of pressure only comes when the task is an important one! "We WILL Trust Him who died for us"! We will embrace the "fellowship of His suffering". Philippians 2:5-8, 3:10, Colossians 1:24-26, 1 Peter 4:13.

We are in the Lord's hands – it's the best place to be, now and forever, and HE continues to bless and guide each and every day, through the midst of the fevers, pain, discomfort and anxieties about bills to pay. Praise His Holy Name. We are called to do His Will, and He will pay the bills and open the door through the

impossibilities in divine power, not by the planning and strategy meetings of limited men! We trust in God alone, as we have learned through the years, we cannot trust ourselves. It is not our plan, but God's Plan, not our strength, but the Holy Spirit's power, and not our deliverance, but God's doorway into the next role before heaven.

We need to look up to the "great company of witnesses" who cheer us on from the stands of heaven. Hebrews 12:1-3. We want to be worthy of them, and "worthy of a song", as our Celtic ancestors would say.

Just in the last weeks the pressures from the people controlling the possibility of sale of Dr McEwan's land increased their open malice towards all affected by their actions. That same day he was advised of this, the border between Nigeria and Benin was closed, meaning it was impossible to get the French Leadership training material across, but we went to prayer, here and in Nigeria and Togo-Benin. The driver was given special permission to cross the border and take the material through, and the USBs arrived ready for distribution. God opened a great door, but the enemy hates it – we all increased our prayer. Orakei Baptist Church donated money to purchase French Bibles, and money saved from the Dean's air fare was used for the purchase of even more bibles.

The Border still remains closed as we write this today in February 2020, and yet our brother and the team, with all the next shipment of books, crossed the border and began the mission to Benin and Togo as they had been led to plan the itinerary. The Mission advanced with success, with only one town missed due to a bridge being washed out and no access to it. On this mission over 10,000 leaders were able to receive training, either in the "Last Days" Manual in Nigeria, or the "Leadership Manual" in the French speaking areas, with over 7000 Sunday school teachers receiving training material, and 1500 USB flash-drives, with 16 GB material on them were given to ministry trainees.

By the 14th of February news had arrived of the power of the revival in the French speaking countries, and their request for 10,000 "Last Words" manuals with the Book of Suffering attached. Translations were being made, and we have gone top prayer again for the costs of the printing to be there in the bank by the time its needed to be sent. Total cost for the October mission was around \$45,000-00, and once again this was given without any appeals, just the Holy Spirit's work upon God's people. The customs in one place charged the team several hundred dollars of "fees" but a brother back in New Zealand donated that money and the debt incurred by the Nigerian home team was covered. God preserved the team in grace and power, with health and safety provided for all. What a blessing has flowed from this mission!

The year of 2019 ended with extreme levels of pressure on both Dr Moses and McEwan, with family, health, personal, and church stressors at a high level. We know the work is important when the pressure increases to this level. We were then asked to assist Dr Mwindula in Zambia with the development of material for a Master's Degree program, and this had been ready in a file of Dr McEwan's since 1991, revised in 2003. This opportunity from Zambia has led to the writing of six new books, that came together very quickly through September-December, and a new file has been added to the Diploma File – "File 14 - Post-Graduate Reading". Twenty six additional books were thoroughly revised in this time period also. These six new books will be sent out as e-books to all contacts to enable them to add to the USB in the New Year 2020 – February - March. These six new books are,

128 The Second Coming of Christ

145 Daniel's Seventieth Week

230 Israelology

Diploma File 14 – Post-Graduate Reading

552 Homiletics

550 Angelic Conflict

551 Dynamic Pastoral Theology

We praise God for the labour of love we are called to in God's Vineyard. What a joy it is to walk with the Lord and daily know the Holy Spirit's comfort and encouragement through the Word. 2019 ended with money donated being sent to Dr Howard Mwindula to cover the costs associated to get him to a conference for Black American Church leaders in Dallas in April 2020, where he will be able to share the USB with the local American pastors. Another box of books from Dr McEwan's library was also able to be sent with an upgraded USB with the six new books on it. No books are to be left on the shelf in his library now unused, when they can be used to train Zambian pastors.

Just in recent weeks Dr McEwan was reminded of the importance of heeding the Holy Spirit, not the distractions of space and time. On his daily fitness walk in a local park a couple called out to him and the wife mentioned that she had been led to give away an EBCWA book to a friend, at just the right moment, as

she heeded the Holy Spirit's "nudge" within her. The result was that the friend became a believer – as the things contained in the book, 115 – "Other Religions", were the facts needed by that friend at that very day. We are reminded that the Plan for our life is God's, the timing of all things is God's, and our responsibility is always the same; be prayerful, Bible saturated, and obedient.

PETER MOSES - THE BIBLE TOPIC BOOKS

Peter became an active Christian in July 1974. At the time he was a senior traffic engineer working for the West Australian Government. Immediately after his conversion he was publically challenged in front of a peer group by another engineer who had had a bad experience with a church, asking why he had done such a foolish thing as becoming a Christian.

He was unable to respond to that question as he knew next to nothing about Christianity. However this was a stimulus for him to find out. He proceeded to scour Christian bookshops for books of topics and was unsuccessful in finding anything which he felt suitable. As a result he began collecting Biblical topics.

Soon after his conversion Peter accepted the Word of God as literally true, thus the topics were compiled in an almost engineering format and all sections were referred back to the Bible with verses quoted.

Eventually Peter published six volumes in the Bible Topic Book series from 1984 to 1991 with the Blue volume being published in December 1984 and the Red one in January 1986. As outlined above these, the first two volumes formed the first connection between John and Peter when a third man gave John the first two books for evaluation on the Auckland Waterfront in mid 1986.

Look at God's timing again here; always perfect, and always way ahead of anything mere men could plan. **Jeremiah 10:23-24**. Note the activities of the two men through these years, and see how God wove their obedience together over these years so that the work could be done.

THE COURSE COMES TO WESTERN AUSTRALIA

In 1988 Peter was awarded a bursary by the Western Australian Government to visit Europe and North America to study and report on traffic safety matters. As a result of the tour the Institute of Engineers in New Zealand invited him to give a five week lecture tour in New Zealand in 1991 on new traffic techniques from the northern hemisphere.

As the tour neared its end Peter found himself in Auckland and made contact with John. During his time with John, Peter asked John if he could send him a couple of audio tapes so that he could widen his tape library.

When a full set of reel to reel tapes arrived, covering the entire 540 hours of the Diploma Theology Course, Peter had no way of playing them. He had however been involved for a number of years with a group who had a faith ministry producing Christian cassette tapes and over the next 18 months Maurice converted the reel to reel tapes to cassette tapes to enable local West Australian students to hear them. Without the Lord's provision of the faith tape ministry the establishment of the course in WA would not have been possible.

A library of the tapes was kept and sent out by Ossie, a teacher, who was the first Course Administrator to enable the correspondence course to be undertaken. Copies of the tapes were taken on to a Bible College in southern India on the first mission trip and to Zambia on the second in 1997.

As the students listened to the tapes they could hear that the material was excellent but before he could recommend the course to others Peter felt the need to listen to all the tapes. As a result a group of seven people decided to do the Diploma of Theology Course commencing in 1992.

Four of those seven, Maurice, Peter, Paul and Stuart eventually completed the course and received Diplomas with Alan receiving a Certificate In Theology.

Most of the group took three years or more to complete the initial course, which was mentored by John McEwan in New Zealand.

THE PROVISION OF A COMPUTER

At the time Peter started to listen to the tapes he received a phone call from the country from a family who had enjoyed the Topic Books and said that they wanted to give him a computer, printer and publishing programme. He was most surprised, so surprised in fact that he told them he would ring back the following day. Within a couple of days a technician arrived and set up his first computer. Previously Peter had decided that he was too old to start learning computers. He soon realized that this was not the Lord's plan!

As he commenced the course Peter decided to make summary notes of all of the lectures. Over the next three years about 1500 pages of notes were taken and keyed into the computer. While at the time he was not sure why he did it, this proved valuable as John's original notes had all been handwritten.

Over the twenty five years of EBCWA we have literally gone from pencil and paper to computer and internet (pencil to the cloud!), from expensive land line phone calls to free visual skype calls, and i-phones that people can use anywhere and download biblical study material into the palm of their hand.

In the 1997 mission to Africa it became clear that the use of cassettes were beyond the means of the people in Zambia and other developing countries due to lack of funds and equipment. As a result of this discovery over a period of 1999 to 2000 John was able to upgrade Peter's notes and thereby provide the whole of the course in writing. All of this was done by email. Without realising it we were being readied for smart phones.

This was also of great value when the advent of the CD enabled the material to be sent out really cheaply, and be electronically accessible the following year by web site. To be able to send out 300 study books on a CD at total cost of \$1-00 plus postage was amazing! Through the years the availability of computers has expanded also in the third world (more about this below).

The first three students from the course in Australia graduated with Diplomas in 1995. The course had been validated and was now ready for promotion.

Having worked for the Government for 28 years Peter decided in 1994 to take the opportunity of applying for a voluntary redundancy and set up his personal traffic engineering consultancy. This had the effect of making his working arrangement more flexible and in subsequent years allowing for him to be available for the 12 short term teaching mission trips using the new material undertaken between 1997 and 2002.

PRAYER FOR OPPORTUNITIES

A major point of progress was a small short prayer meeting held in a tower overlooking the Indian Ocean just north of Perth, when a group of four men in early winter of 1996 prayed that the Lord would open up opportunities for service. The Lord has shown us through the years that it is the prayer of faith that God honours, and that when we are led to pray for something, no matter how "outlandish" to unsaved men, we are called to stand firm in prayer for God to work in accordance with His Plan, and power, not our limitations.

Here we prayed facing out over the Indian Ocean, and in the driving rain asked the Lord to open the door to work in Africa, Asia, and all the other countries in the north west of Perth. Over the years we have seen this prayer so wonderfully answered with significant ministry in Africa, Asia and Ukraine. Truly we have seen the Lord bless things that are insignificant to unsaved men, and we have learned not to "despise the day of small things", for small prayer meetings open amazing mission fields. Zechariah 4:10.

The Lord abundantly answered that prayer and in 2005 Peter, and Howard from Zambia, who Peter did not meet until 1997, visited the tower and offered prayers of thanks and continued guidance and blessings in the future for the ministry of EBCWA. We give thanks for the work of God through all his obedient servants led to work with us in EBCWA through the years.

We have been blessed with brethren who pray for the college. John and Peter were both very aware of this on their missions overseas where they were by themselves in an alien culture.

The Lord calls us all to serve in various ways, and each person finding their own ministry in the plan of God is the philosophy of EBCWA, and the prayer ministry supports and protects all others.

A prayer calendar was produced covering a four month period in 2004. With the continual expansion of EBCWA the concept of an annual prayer calendar was extended to a full year.

This prayer letter was emailed to all involved conforming with the concept of praying for each other. In this way many could be encouraged and the focus on our Lord as the source of the college can be maintained

"We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you", Col 1:3.

PROVISIONS BY THE LORD TO ENABLE EBCWA TO FUNCTION - 1996-2019

As the college in Western Australia and beyond developed over these years the provision of the Lord was seen in many ways both in guidance, personnel and funds for the college to operate.

Over this period it changed from a cassette tape based correspondence course to a book and computer based course and Christian library resource using CD's and compressed data DVDs. We will now examine some of these developments.

[1] GUIDANCE

UKRAINE

The third EBCWA mission for Peter was scheduled to be split between Kazakhstan and Ukraine with two weeks in the former country and a week in Ukraine. The previous missions to India, Nepal and Zambia had been arranged without undue problems but the door kept on shutting for Peter as far as Kazakhstan was concerned.

Seeing this, another John, a friend of Peter said he would sponsor Peter to go to Ukraine as John was supporting a Pastor there. Peter agreed and arrangements went very smoothly.

As a result sufficient time on the first Ukraine mission was made available to arrange a detailed review of the topic book series which within the year had been converted to a Russian translation. As with all books and publications this book was given away free of charge. The invaluable work of Kostya the pastor, Oxana the interpreter and Nick the editor was critical in this venture.

SOUTH AFRICA

John McEwan planned to join Peter Moses on the 2001 mission to Zambia. As he had the furthest to travel John attempted to book a flight from Auckland to Perth and hence to Johannesburg. He was unsuccessful. When Peter tried there was no booking available on the day he needed.

Late that evening an email arrived from a church in Port Elizabeth advising that if Peter was in South Africa at any time they would sponsor a visit to Port Elizabeth.

Peter as a result decided to extend the mission by a week without affecting the Zambian conference times and the following morning was able to book the modified trip. At this conference in Port Elizabeth contacts were made that would open the prisons of South Africa to the Diploma Program within ten years.

It is of interest that on previous occasions Qantas the Australian airline had flown straight to Harare but that service had been removed from the schedule a few months prior to this mission. Without the relocation of the air service the requirement to arrive in South Africa would not have occurred.

The result of this visit to South Africa could never have been imagined at the time. We had not even thought of prayed about the possibility for prisoners to be able to study the material in jail and train to become pastors.

One day four years later Peter received a land line phone call at his home from a South African jail. It was from a prisoner, using the Governor of the Prison's phone in his office.

The prisoner, Michael, serving 957 years for multiple violent crimes had been saved in jail, had led over 200 men to the Lord there, and had started a Bible College in the jail using the EBCWA Diploma Course material.

The Governor of the prison came on the line and thanked Peter for the material and reported the transformation wrought in his prison by the work of the Holy Spirit through the saved prisoners and the Diploma Course. The Course is now available and accepted in many prisons of South Africa, backed by the Bible Society who provide the Bibles, the guards and the chaplains who provide the pencils and paper.

UNEXPECTED VISIT TO PERTH

Howard Mwindula the officer in charge of EBCWA Zambia had been scheduled to fly to the USA for a series of seminars in 2005 but due to US visa problems was unable to make the journey. The airline refused to refund the funds Howard had been allocated by the US group so he used the funds to undertake a mission to Perth. In conjunction with a visit from John from Auckland a valuable face to face planning meeting for EBCWA therefore became unexpectedly available.

Even as late as October of 2014 things like this continue to happen, with the local second hand Christian book shop in Auckland being forced to relocate with a rent rise, at the very time that Howard needed books for his theological library in Lusaka. Money was gifted for the freight and the purchase of the books at a heavily discounted price. Over 2000 good books were able to sent over to Lusaka to enable them to secure accreditation later in 2015. Also a few weeks before this John had received an amount of cash and wondered why it had been received, but this proved the exact amount required to send over five additional boxes of theological study books by airmail from his own library.

THE MAN FROM SINGAPORE

At the end of the first mission a change of schedule saw Peter early in the morning lining up for a seat on the flight to Singapore at New Delhi airport. An Englishman had an altercation regarding departure tax with the booking clerk and huffed off to get the necessary stamp. He arrived back just as Peter was about to talk to the clerk and Peter deferred to him.

When Peter boarded he was allocated an aisle seat next to a small Indian boy. His mother asked me if it would be possible for him to change seats with her husband who was in the row behind. Agreeing to this he sat down next to the irate Englishman who was based in the oil industry in Singapore. They discussed Christian things and the Englishman admitted that at University he had been active in Christian circles.

Peter invited him to call if he was ever in Perth. He said he never came to Australia but two weeks later Peter received a phone call from the Englishman. He was in Perth and they were able to meet again. The Englishman returned to Singapore with some college Christian material in his briefcase.

We need always to be relaxed about where we go and what we do for the Lord. If we are in fellowship with Him he knows where our service is going to be most effective.

"Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5,6

[2] PERSONNEL AND PRACTICES

COMPACT DISCS AND PRINTING

The printing press for the Bible College has been located behind a car repair garage, where the books and CD's were produced by men who work on a voluntary basis. The story of the Lord's bringing these men together through a breakdown of one's car and it being towed to the car yard for repair as it could not be started is quite remarkable.

On Sunday mornings both men attended their different churches unknown to each other, but the Lord purposed to bring them together. One shopping day one of the men discovered his car would not start, called the Automobile Association, and they contacted the second man, asking him would he be able to check his car as it would not start..... On that fateful day after the car had been towed to the repair garage the two men discussed the Bible College work as each discovered the other was a Christian.

After the two men had shared the things of the Lord, John, the owner of the premises went out to see what was wrong with the car. The Mechanic started the car straight away, and it has not stopped since!

The other man, Fred, a retiree then in his 70s, has continued to work for the College as his ministry since that day producing large quantities of books on second hand photocopiers and then hand binding them.

John is the man who burns the new college CDs on his business computer, each one taking ten minutes while he works on other administration work for his business. He has produced thousands of CDs over the years by this quiet and focused work. This again is an example of optimising ones activity and time management.

Another John, a computer expert has also become involved in the CD with electronic conversion of the CD contents into various formats electronically. This again was on a voluntary basis.

THE WRITERS

The Lord brought together a number of mature Christians who have a deep desire to provide sound Biblical material in a form which is easily understandable yet effective. Often it is found that Theological material is heavy and somewhat obscure. Bearing in mind some of the people using the material use English as a second or official language it is important that all written work is kept simple yet accurate targeted to equip third world leaders for ministry in difficult places.

TRANSLATORS

Translations are seen as a response to the material by bilingual Christians where they see the need for non English speaking people to have the benefit of studying in their own language. Some of the material has been translated into Japanese, Marathi, Russian, Spanish, Swahili and Tamil. The on-line translating applications now available will speed this process, and we may see all material translated within a few years.

INDIA

In the case of Marathi a pastor's wife in India translated the Condensed Bible Topic book into the language of 70 million Indians living near Mumbai. Whilst originally not available electronically books were photocopied and re exported to India. In 2012 it was scanned onto the computer so that it would be available on CD 2012.

In one case a copy of the Marathi book was sent in a box of books to a group in Bangalore where this language was not spoken. However within a couple of days a man off the street walked into the learning centre and asked if they had any material in Marathi. He received the book and was later seen using it to evangelise and teach a group of Hindus near the learning centre.

RUSSIAN

On the third mission which was the first to Ukraine Peter's translator Oxana said she had been praying for a person who would teach her more about the Bible. Peter had taken the Omnibus edition of the Bible Topic Book which had some 400 topics in it.

During the mission of three weeks Oxana and Peter went through the book line by line over a period of 60 hours. In places Oxana would say that they did not have this in the Russian and on explanation would make notes on the book.

As a result a book covering some 200 topics was produced in Russian in the Ukraine. This was followed later by the Prophecy book. The books were distributed free of charge to pastors, Bible teachers and students. Long term missionaries heading for Russia and other old Soviet republics took copies for distribution on their mission.

Here again we see prepared and caring Christians working diligently towards the goal of providing assistance for those who wish to grow.

On the 2002 mission to Ukraine electronic copies of the Russian translation of these books plus Genesis 1-11 were obtained allowing them to be placed on the college CD.

A subsequent development was the use of this electronic material through Nick the editor of the Russian books using material both in Russian and English in a distance learning programme by CD from a Bible College in Kiev. Russian speakers living in New Zealand who attended the Bible studies there are now taking material back to their families in both Ukraine and Russia.

During the 2008 mission undertaken by Peter and his wife Jan copies of the books heavily used were shown to them indicating the lasting value of them in Russian speaking areas.

LEARNING CENTRES

Some months after the second mission in 1998 a letter arrived from Zambia asking for study material to establish a Bible school in Zambia. This learning centre under the supervision of Howard Mwindula and his faithful lecturers soon had many more graduates with Diplomas and Certificates in Theology than in Australia.

Subsequently many mentors for learning centres have been accredited in many countries. Often as students graduate, having seen the benefit of the course some are setting up autonomous learning centres in their own churches.

EBCWA provides written material free of charge as the Lord allows but the individuals are responsible for running the course and mentoring students themselves. This allows the option of submitting assignments in a language other than in English as has occurred in Southern India.

The provision through an American charity of used computers, laptops and i-phones into Africa is transforming the study of God's Word through that continent as pastors receive free I-Phones, I-Macs and I-Pads and teach themselves English as well as computers, and then discover our CDs and websites and utilize the material. In a recent example, CDs had been sent to Ethiopia but limited English language had limited their effectiveness and nothing was heard from our contacts there for two years. Suddenly English language emails began to arrive, reporting the benefits of the material. The Ethiopian pastors had been given older I-Macs by an American Charity and through their programs had taught themselves English and computing, and could now freely use all the material. It is a matter of great humour between Dr Moses and Dr McEwan that these pastors in Ethiopia using their "older ex-USA Mac's" are actually using more modern computers than both the Dean and Chairman! The Lord has a great sense of humour.

The world of training is being revolutionized. These pastors are then also able to utilize the "U-Tube" method of teaching and learning, and that is the new direction that the Lord appears to be leading us in from 2015 onwards. "For such a time as this.....". Esther 4:14. We remain alert to "who" controls the Internet through this time, as international government changes may make it impossible to utilize the Net for Christian work in years to come.

EBCWA IN ZAMBIA

DR HOWARD MWINDULA - DIRECTOR FOR EAST AND SOUTHERN AFRICA wrote in 2005

"In 1997 Pastor Steward Sichilongo asked me to host three brothers in the Lord from Australia waiting for a flight back to Australia after speaking at a Conference in Kabwe, Zambia. Among the three there was Peter Moses who introduced himself to me as the Chairman of EBCWA and handed me a big Topic book of Bible Doctrines. After going through it months after he had gone I discovered it was full of hidden treasure that can turn anybody in the ministry into a skilful worker in God's vineyard.

In 1998 I wrote to Dr Moses to see if we could learn and teach the material to the many active and untrained pastors in our region. He agreed and later sent tapes and returned to Zambia in late 1998. We had our first ten day seminar, one on Systematic Theology, in Lusaka in 1999.

Thereafter learning centres have been set up in Lusaka, Kasama and in one of the rural areas in the North Western part of Zambia. We have gone as far as Tanzania and in August 2005 may see the setting up of learning centres in Uganda." Learning centres have spread out from Lusaka, so that by 2015 they stretch from South Sudan to Namibia, all planted by God's grace and God's timely and precise provision of financial resources when they were needed for separate missions to plant, train and equip the new colleges."

We are an Evangelical Church with a vision to plant local churches in all urban and rural centres.

We would like to ask your College to allow us to run a course to train our Church leaders who have been earmarked to lead the local churches.

As we discussed with the Principal when he visited Lusaka last year and stayed with me for three (03) days. I would be most grateful if the Course can be sent to us on Tapes (one set) and we can duplicate them and use them at our Centre in Kasama. Or if possible to send us the lessons on computer diskettes and we can run the pamphlets for our students.

If you would like to monitor the course, we can be sending the tests for marking there or you can allow our trained Pastors to mark and only send the results to you to issue the Certificates or Diplomas.

As for graduation of the Students, we would like your representative to come and officiate the ceremonies.

If this idea is accepted, we also will consider all Evangelical and other denominations that can accept the Doctrine of the College to participate in the Course.

I remain waiting to hear from you soon.

Over 500 church leaders in Zambia have graduated with a Certificate in Theology with many going on to complete the Diploma in Theology, and then train others. The principle is multiplication through the Holy Spirit's teaching ministry upon the trainees. Apart from people learning in the centres many CD's have been given out to some lecturers of Bible schools and some of the EBCWA books have been given to untrained but very active pastors. The Pastoral Theology Manual is used by many pastors as a handbook in their ministries in local churches throughout Africa. The Minister's Manual, 114, was specifically written to assist these leaders.

MENTORS AND GLOBAL AND GRATIS

An alternate method of training arose associated with the provision of CD EBCWA where there came the opportunity for distance learning where mentor and student have the CD and access to email. As a result a programme called 'Global and Gratis' was established for that crucial decade to 2015.

Over this period of time various mature Christians accepted the position of mentors. By 2005 there were mentors in Australia, Malaysia, Namibia, United Kingdom and United States

With distance being no obstacle on the Internet a mentor in UK had a student in El Salvador while Australian mentors had students in Canada and India. The only cost for the course was the email cost of sending and marking assignments. This allowed for making quality training available free of charge so that all is required is a desire to study to the glory of God. The student could therefore be trained in his or her own environment without disruption of family or expense. This continues today but now centred in the various Directorates around the globe, rather than being administered from Australia.

GRADUATES

Two examples are given where the Global and Gratis programme has assisted, as an encouragement to prayer for local colleges, as through the expanding internet this model for training can be run from anywhere now with the EBCWA Disc and Web Based material.

A Malaysian medical doctor supervised by a mentor in Malaysia ran very effective short term medical missions, and has now become a full time missionary.

A Zambian who was supervised by a mentor in the United Kingdom is setting up a learning centre in Zambia and is himself starting mentoring students with his UK mentor lan now acting as the supervising mentor.

"Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth." 2 Timothy 2:15

THE VIRTUAL COLLEGE

The emergence of the internet and email, and the advent of the CD/DVD now has given opportunity to send large amounts of publications globally at low cost. The first CD was manufactured by John Richardson in April 2001. The administration of the virtual college is from a room in a private house with an email service. The web site is also administered privately.

Over the last decade CDs have become compressed DVDs and now in many areas we are moving towards small flash drives with multi GB storage on them that was incomprehensive a few years ago.

The cost to produce a 16 GB "flash drive" is falling to be around \$6-00 and this contains 1500+ hours of MP3 teaching, plus over 300 study books. From these small devices computers can be "loaded up" with study material by visiting missionaries and teachers, leaving that computer as a permanent training resource centre, that can itself be a centre for future multiplication. This may become a crucial factor in the future years as control of the Internet by the UN may limit or eliminate evangelical Christian use of it for training purposes. Under the Western Dictator to come it will eventually become a tool of control and persecution, a source of "evidence" that the Christian using it is "an enemy of the New World Order".

We openly use the Internet at this time, and will continue to utilize this tool until it becomes dangerous to do so. With no expensive administration space and costs, we therefore are able to keep an unassuming profile while concentrating on the work that our Lord has guided us to do for Him. Our only visible asset was a single post office box and even that was a private one. We are not listed in the telephone book. If we were any more virtual we would not exist! This is the best approach and we encourage all our local colleges to do this also into the future; the lower the profile and the fewer the assets, the harder it is for the enemy to locate and destroy the ministry.

This "under the radar" philosophy is the one the Lord has guided us to, and we encourage all who use our material to adopt it. The use of CDs, and Flash Drives in the future, loading up computers no longer connected to the Internet, will remain the key "under the radar" source of training resources for all local work.

ADVERTISING

The only advertising by the College itself has been via our website where many of the contacts have originated. Others have come by people being shown the literature or friends giving them a CD. The Lord has led people to us just as he led people into the wilderness to hear John the Baptist, and so the Lord has proved his marketing strategy better than that of men.

A single advertising flyer was sent out with the Maranatha Revival Crusade booklet to coincide with the launch of CD EBCWA 2001 in April of that year. In addition one of our UK colleagues has advised others by internet of particular books. Advertising has therefore been minimal, just as the Lord has led individuals to do it. A further single flyer was sent out a decade later resulting in many contacts which were then serviced with CD's and books. We depend on prayer alone, and that has released the power of God in this work.

DISTRIBUTORS AND COPYRIGHT

As the material is free of copyright it allows for the copying and distribution of material based on the motivation of the person. Examples of this form of ministry range from an invalid in Australia to a librarian in Ghana who copy and give out CD's, a computer repairer in the USA who copies material onto computers for the Native Americans and a Bible college in Swaziland, and a pastor in Vanuatu who copies and distributes material in his country. This is done freely. Our Motto remains - "Every Church a Bible College - Freely you received, and so freely give".

SUMMARY ON PERSONNEL AND PRACTICE

As seen above the Lord has brought together a wide range of people to be associated with EBCWA. They come from many different countries and backgrounds.

To get some idea of the diversity in Australasia the Lord has seen fit to bring together a business proprietor, stress counsellor, taxi driver, motor cycle instructor, accountant, retired telephone technician, a teacher, retired fitter, a moulder, a missionary, and engineers as the authors and prime workers within the college

production group with an average age of well over sixty. They remain totally united in desiring to provide good material to all who desire it, and work on a voluntary basis for God's Glory.

Different people have different gifts yet they are still "of the one body". By keeping your eyes on the Lord and concentrating on areas to which the Lord has directed you, you will have no distractions and you will discover as we have, that through the uniting power of the Holy Spirit the body works together. Each is confident of the other and there is no rivalry. We have a saying "Keep to your own knitting". By our focus upon the work of the Lord and walking in the Holy Spirit we have not fallen out with each other at any time.

We have been impressed by the philosophy of George Muller, and the approach taken always by the Apostles; that prayer was the power house of the church, and the Holy Spirit the guide for all growth and expansion. We have learned to pray, never argue with men, and heed the Holy Spirit rather than follow after the plans and thoughts of men.

"For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ."

[3] PROVISION

PRINCIPLE

John writes in his report to EBCWA [NZ], "All workers continue to work on a voluntary basis, and we have always reinforced the principle of grace and faith strongly. No money will ever be asked for, and all will work on a faith and gracious basis. Freely the Lord has given to us and freely we give. What a joy this work is as we see what the Lord has done through us all, bringing together pastors, writers of commentaries, missionaries, and financial supporters, all for the advancement of his kingdom."

Two areas in relation to the Lord's provision are now examined, the timely arrival of funds and lack of work.

MATERIAL PROVISION

On numerous occasions the Lord has provided from various unsolicited sources funds for tasks. These donors invariably request that the source of their gifts remain anonymous. To those who have and continue to give we say that without this support EBCWA could not function. Two examples of the many times the Lord has provided will illustrate the material provision by our Lord.

CD 2006

John McEwan was working with clients in his private counselling practice in Auckland when there was a knock on the door. He ignored the knock but it was repeated and excusing himself he went to the door. A lady who he had never seen before asked if he was Dr McEwan involved with the Bible College. Having affirmed that he was, she handed him an envelope.

He returned to his counselling sessions with his clients leaving the envelope on the office table and after the clients had left he opened the envelope finding a substantial sum of money with a note asking that it be used by the college. There was no name or address and so the donors remain unknown.

At that time the world wide issue of CD EBCWA 2006 was planned together with additional books being sent out to isolated learning centres without computers, and an unexpected board meeting occurred in Perth with Howard from Zambia. We were all together able to praise God for his gracious gift. Those funds would therefore send out over 1000 libraries of books to nearly 100 countries. The benefactor's gift was to multiply blessings globally. This occurred again in 2015, so that over a thousand flash drives could be funded into the third world by one gift received without any request being made.

TEACHING MISSION

In all cases of missions from Australia or New Zealand the missionary requires to be able to fund not only the journey, but often the travel and provision expenses incurred on a mission, as the ministry is generally to

those who are on extremely limited budgets. We must often feed the attendees with physical as well as spiritual food.

Peter was invited to go on a teaching mission which required a series of three administrators to travel with him to three different Bible colleges. The requesting body emailed some 4 weeks before the visit to say that they were embarrassed by not having funds to cover the travel for the administrators.

Peter looked at the funds for EBCWA and found there was \$50 in the funds, which was obviously not enough, so he passed it over to the Lord. At that time Peter lived in a rural area and rarely had visitors.

Within an hour a lady of limited means whom Peter knew but had not previously assisted the ministry materially arrived at the house knocked on the door and said that the Lord had laid on her heart to give some funds for the Lord's work. After she had gone Peter opened the envelope he found exactly the amount of funds required to cover the administrators' expenses. He was able to contact the mission leaders and advised that the mission would happen as the Lord had supplied the needed funds.

On another occasion funds were short for an upcoming mission trip. Unexpectedly an American missionary visited and as he was leaving gave Peter a sum of money for the ministry which proved to be exactly the amount required to fund the shortfall.

On a number of occasions friends would quietly and privately approach John or Peter providing funds for EBCWA. Without them some of the missions would never have taken place nor boxes of book find their way to all corners of the world. Funds were never sought but the Lord made them available through faithful brethren. In addition from time to time a church or Christian organisation has contributed to the cost of sending out boxes of books. All in all and by different means the Lord through His faithful people has provided our needs.

LACK OF PAID WORK

This may appear to be a rather odd concept to have under the heading of provisions but it has an important place in the Lord's plan. Several times secular work has ceased with no remuneration for a period for both Peter and John. They have been challenges to faith, as our only income was our businesses.

These periods however have always been complemented with the requirement to provide extra time in writing material. John has recently found this in his work on Isaiah, the Arabs, and Genesis, while Peter compiled a book requested by contacts in the Philippines on the subject of Prophecy in a work break of several days.

In both cases the secular work recommenced as soon as the task was completed.

"Be strong,saith the Lord, and work! For I am with you says the Lord of Hosts, Fear Not!" Haggai 2:4-5

"But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19

E-BOOKS

From 2004 E-books have been sent out to numerous recipients around the world with often multiple books being despatched each year. They are free of charge apart from downloading costs and free of copyright. By 2006 the number of recipients of E Books had grown to 700 with a larger number of books being sent out.

This continues to be the main means of providing material at no cost, and will be expanding with the "Cloud" technology now available. All borders can be slid through with Christian material, and that is our mission, to train God's people where-ever they are positive to the Word of God.

PRAYER UNION

In 2005 a prototype prayer union was trialled and in 2006 this was consolidated into a Prayer Union where over 300 people worldwide were listed for prayer on a daily basis. A specific prayer letter for the persecuted was taken up by Wendy, one of our mentors. This has continued intermittently over the years to allow fellow

associates to pray for each other as well as corporate prayer for brethren being persecuted in many countries around the world.

TAMIL TRANSLATIONS

A Tamil translation of the Bible Topic Book was received by Administration and placed on CD 2012. Peter on searching the web found a site requesting that Tamil Churches provide their details. He found that over 3000 churches and associations had registered of which over 1800 had given email addresses. Over a period individual copies of our Tamil translation were sent out. In 2013-2015 a further seven books, translated into Tamil were sent out to 1865 Tamil Church contacts. As a result of the work of two associates in Bangalore many around the world have been provided with additional material. Our Tamil translator John Vincent Raj is now in the presence of the Lord, having completed 14 volumes translated into Tamil which have all been distributed by E book as well as being included on CD and USB.

DIFFERENT LEVELS OF MATERIAL PROVIDED IN DELEGATING OUR WORK

After over 20 years of working from Western Australia we are currently in a position of delegating our work to associates in different countries. In July 2012 our learning centre mentors were advised that the responsibility of running courses would rest with them and that we in Western Australia would not be accepting further students. In addition all current students as of that time would need to graduate within three years as Certificates and Diplomas would not be issued by the Administrator after mid 2015.

This resulted in a review of the requirements of existing associates of EBCWA, with them all being offered additional material to enable them to continue if they so wished in training and certificating students in the future.

Our associates cover the complete range as far as the ability to use our material. There are a large group who do not yet have access to computers and therefore using our CD is not an option, although this may change in the years to come with the Computer and smart phone gifting charities at work from the USA. There are others who do not yet have access to MP3 technology and there are still those who have all the modern technology.

In addition there are countries where a natural progression to a national bible college based on the EBCWA format is possible such as in Zambia. In other cases the number of associates is such that individual ministry is the solution while in others association with like minded mission groups is the optimum.

In 2013 a large number of associates in developing countries were personally emailed to determine what would be best in the changeover. This covered the groups who have no computer or have limited access to a computer.

As a result boxes of book 20 as well as individual copies of the Minister's Handbook 114, which allows the teaching of Systematic and Pastoral Theology using a Bible alone are being progressively despatched. In addition CD's are being sent out to associates.

With the complete Diploma course being on MP3 these associated are also assessed regarding the supply of all the material which is now housed on two compressed "DVD" discs instead of the old CDs. These two compressed DVDs can now be loaded onto a new generation "flash/pencil drive" that can be attached to a key ring and used to load up computers with all our material in under ten minutes.

The last major posting out of these CDs occurred in early September 2019, with over 900 libraries going to our contacts world wide. We trust the Lord as to where these will end up and the people blessed by the material will only be known in heaven.

The plan is to develop a new interactive Bible study website. This will be more for the use of associates in the developed world and we look forward to seeing how the Lord arranges this. The future control and ownership of the Internet will determine where and how this idea develops. The "U-Tube" teaching option is also being explored for on going teaching into the Pacific and the World and will be part of a new phone-app friendly web site.

We were concerned over debates about the Internet's ownership and administration in 2015 which made us wonder whether we have much time left to utilize this amazing tool for the Lord's work. We walk prayerfully in

this matter as in all things to date. We have focused on getting material out in USB and CD format so that even when the Internet falls into the enemy's hands material is "out there" and cannot be stopped.

CONCLUSION

As always we need to keep our focus on the Lord Jesus Christ for without Him we can do nothing and it is only His Plan we seek to fulfil. We have no "plans" for ourselves, or from our own minds, for we have learned that we are limited creatures, and we seek the Lord's plan and His Glory alone. **Jeremiah 10:23-24**. To our mind the above brief outline of the Providence of the Lord for EBCWA demonstrates that the Lord can use an apparently insignificant, diverse group of Christians as the assigned part of His plan. Our challenge is to be sure of each step we take, that we stay within His Plan, not our own thoughts, and that it is His Almighty Power, not any power/devices of men. **Zechariah 4:6-10**.

Please continue to pray for the use of the EBCWA material as it heads out around the world and is used in local contexts in the years to come once we have wound up the Australia based ministry. May the Lord continue to bless you as you listen to what the Lord wants you to do in your own local mission areas. We would not live any other way than apply these principles that the Lord has shown us through these 25 years into the fabric of our daily lives.

Retirement is for heaven, and then we will worship and learn forever even more about the mighty grace and wonder of the Lord our God. Until then we press onwards towards the finishing tape of the race of our lives, seeking new ways to glorify the Lord and praise his Holy Name as the Holy Spirit reveals the path before our feet. Follow us in joy and worship his Holy Name for what he has done, is doing, and yet will do with us all. In our weakness his strength shines through.

Learning Centres

There were 2680 students who graduated with Certificates of Theology of which 853 graduated with the full Diploma in 105 centres from 2003 to 2015 who reported graduations.

With the cessation of issuing of certification from EBCWA the encouragement of those interested on the course turned towards local participation and control. In South and East Africa we continued to see new graduates and the development of the course to BTh level with our first graduates in 2019 under the oversight of Director Howard Mwindula

In addition there were a series of seminars in Nigeria, Ghana, Benin and Togo under the leadership of Director Williams Adesina involving the translation of the Dean's book 112a into French in 2018

The provision and revision of material continued as did the use of E books. This included the completions of the books of the Bible with the publication of 1st and 2nd Chronicles and a major project based on the Greek Perfect in 2018 to 2019 resulting in a dozen volumes.

STARTING A NEW MINISTRY

If the Lord leads us to establish a new mission, it is with the power of the Holy Spirit **ALONE** that it must be established. If God does not build the house those that labour do so in vain. We must trust God not men, and depend upon prayer power not marketing or asking others for resources. Our first principle is therefore PRAYER for the Lord to open the doors and provide what is needed directly to enable HIS work to be done.

It is also an EBCWA principle that we do not ask anyone for money. We are a Faith Mission, and that means we pray, we work, we announce what God is doing, and leave provision to the sovereign will of the Lord. If resources are not there, we cannot advance, and we do not advance, for it is the Lord's harvest, not ours. If we cannot move forward through lack of funds, in the Lord's Sovereign Plan, it is because another has the job, or we are not ready.

We pray and wait, but we do not ask others for funds. Paul sets the example in Acts 16:6-12.

If we feel "led" to establish a ministry, but resources are lacking locally, we must get upon our knees and seek the way the Lord wants it established. Our experience is that it will be done without large buildings needing to be purchased, or any equipment initially. God has led us to establish Bible Colleges in ways that do not have any administrative costs, and where the Lord provides the money for the pastors to do what is required on a weekly basis.

EBCWA Operating Principles

- 1. If the Lord leads us in a direction the Lord will provide for us there if it is truly His Plan and His time for the plan to be executed. Pray for the Lord's provisions alone.
- 2. Do not ask any man for money, simply announce the ministry and advance into it in prayer, seeking the Lord's provision as you go. God rarely gives lots of money to establish things, but seeks our walk of faith to ensure things are provided when needed in a way that honours Him and brings glory to His holy name. Jesus gets the glory not any men.
- 3. Gather prayer warriors around you immediately, and have them pray daily for the needs, but open your eyes and seek the humble brother/sister with the loaves and fishes, not the "Rich Young Rulers" who hold onto their wealth. God works through the poor and rich people, but only those who commit themselves to him with all they have.
- 4. Do not seek a trouble free path, for it will probably not be the Lord's path. Matthew 7:13-23 tells us that the Lord's path is always the "narrow/constricted" way. We have to squeeze through tight places on His path in prayer and with perspiration at times. Pray, trust, wait, and move as the door opens and you have the resources to advance through it.
- 5. Do not wait for a full bank account, for what is "full"? Step out and minister as the door opens and you have the opportunity, and the funds to arrive at the place of ministry, and speak there. If you cannot reach the place, you are not meant to be there. Be ready to personally work in manual labour, your trade, or in any task that you can, to fund your own ministry. All ministries must be LOCAL and supported locally. Do not fall into the "American Prosperity Gospel" trap, for it is a lie. We stand with the Apostle Paul, and he worked by day and preached by night. Acts 18:1-3, 19:8-12, 1 Corinthians 4:9-16, 15:9-11
- 6. EBCWA was established with this Pauline (and biblical) mental attitude. Paul didn't pray over handkerchiefs, he sweated as he worked, and it was those "sweat cloths" that healed the sick. Many men today seek "sweat-less" ministry, but God's Holy Word indicates that such are fake and crooked. God works with those who sweat in the work! If you are not ready to do that you must find another group to work with.
- 7. EBCWA began with myself (Dr McEwan) very ill, and very poor, through inability to work. We were given premises to use (we never owned them, and moved on from them four years later) and started without any funds above those needed to get the building useful. I provided my own transport (or was driven by students) and each person their own bibles and study books, and we started. God blessed greatly as we advanced, but not with money in abundance, just enough to advance to the end with joy in our hearts.
- 8. In the prisons of Southern Africa we see the same things happening today (2011-2015). The prisoners have a Bible from the Bible Society, and note paper and a pencil, and the prisoner teaching has a study book and their Bible and they begin with nothing else.

We now provide the notes on CD or flash drive to be down loaded onto any Prison computers, and the Power Points to use when teaching the Diploma Course if the facility has a projector and computer, but these are not needed. In your local situation, my beloved brother and sister, just start with a set of notes and your Bible open, but start with prayer and work with prayer, and end with prayer.

We found that the prison authorities themselves provided printing of the books needed for prisoners as the courses advanced when they saw the "fruit" in the lives of the prisoners. **Matthew 7:13-23**. Prisons were transformed by the course and the prison officers provided help for the men and women they once despised and feared, who they now saw were their brothers and sisters in Christ.

- 9. STARTING OUT Prepare yourself by studying the Course from the CD or website. Be ready to teach it. Pray for the People, and the Premises as I did all those years ago. Step out to meet the needs with your Bible open and the notes under your arm, and see the Lord provide for what the poor need in your local area. If it is Bibles, pray for that need to be met. If it is for pencils and paper, pray for that to be met, or transport, pray for that.
- 10. Do not wait for computers, power point projectors, smart phone, or cars to drive you to the place of ministry! If they are there use them, but do not depend on expensive technology, use the simplest things, for Satan finds the simplest things the hardest to oppose and destroy. Be like Paul, work and provide for your own team yourself and advance into the God anointed ministry.

Trust God, build a local ministry and serve the local churches.

Do not depend upon foreigners, for they can be easily cut off from you by the enemy.

Trust the Lord alone and keep as low cost as you can, for Satan finds it hard to eliminate poor people who have no support structures to destroy.

We have prayer and we can work and perspire in the Lord's work.

Let us do that and trust God alone. If God builds, no man can tear down!

Jesus our Lord can be trusted.

Trust in Him alone, His Plan, His Power in the Holy Spirit, and seek His glory forever.
